Outline of the role:

Requirements:

- Supporting Admin in the booking in process for all International groups and ensuring that all information is passed on to them directly.
- Ensuring that all International visitors arrive and leave Poacher 2021.
- Attending meetings before the Jamboree in order to meet other team leaders and keep up-to-date with the planning and organisation of Poacher 2021.
- Ensuring the International team budget is set and adhered to.
- Recruiting and leading a team to support International groups throughout their Poacher 2021 adventure and provide a range of activities and events in the International marquee during the Jamboree.
